WOMEN EARN MORE, INHERIT MORE, AND LIVE LONGER

THIS ECONOMIC SHIFT ADDS UP TO WOMEN CONTROLLING SIGNIFICANT WEALTH NOW AND CONTINUED GROWTH OF THEIR WEALTH AND DECISION-MAKING FOR DECADES TO COME.

PHILANTHROPIC SHIFT

With INCREASED EARNINGS and education, women have an INCREASED FOCUS on philanthropy.

SINGLE WOMEN ARE MORE LIKELY than similarly-situated single men to give to charity. WOMEN GIVE SIGNIFICANTLY MORE than similarly-situated men at almost all income levels.

WOMEN ARE NOW MAKING OF PARTICIPATING

in the majority of household philanthropic decisions.

For every \$10,000 that the wife's income increases, total household giving increases by more than 5 PERCENT. In comparison, for every \$10,000 the husband's income increases, total household giving increases by 3 percent.
